**College of Humanities  
Graduate Research Funding Policy**

Graduate student research may be funded by the College of Humanities when that research supports the scholarly project of a faculty member. Generally, graduate student research is supported by wage money requested that is by a faculty member through the online application for research funding.

In exceptional circumstances, a faculty member can request travel funding through that same system to support research done by a graduate student to support faculty research. Such travel funding for graduate students, requested by a faculty member to support an ongoing project, cannot exceed \$800.

Graduate students can receive travel funding from the College—whether for research or for conference participation—only once during a twelve-month period.
